Good conformation with fine, extremely dense rose-grey fleece. Multiple first-place winner – CABA, AWE, EVAA, AlpacaAffaire – in halter, fleece, and composite classes.

Obi's crias - fawns, blacks, silver and rose-greys – include a silver male who took second at the Monterey Pronk and a brown female Reserve Color champion at Heart of the Valley.



### AJ's Peruvian Champion

What a pedigree! His sire is AOBA color champion Nautilus, whose donated breeding sold for \$19,000; his dam is full sister to Microsoft; his grandsires are Hemingway and Camilio.

Champ's superb Accoyo heritage is reflected in his fleece: great character, brightness and 10 crimps/inch.

His crias range in color from white to medium brown. His brown daughter took a first at Heart of the Valley.

Champ had Reserve Champion Fleece, Heart of the Valley, 2006. He also placed 4th (of 10) in the halter show; the judge called him one of the top two in the class, but moved him down because he was "too pudgy!"
